ACCOMMODATED WORK COMMITTEE REPORT

The Accommodated Work Committee is made up of members from ONA 80 Executive, Manager of Occupational Health, Return to Work Coordinators, Human Resources Rep, and the Hospital Labour Relations Manager. This committee meets the third Thursday of the month hoping to locate suitable jobs for members within their restrictions in order to place them into a permanent accommodation.

This committee was formed in 2001 and, since then, has successfully placed 89 members into a permanent or temporary position. There are currently 8 members on active list requiring accommodation, of which the committee is diligently looking for jobs that fall within their restrictions. There are also 7 members on the dormant list whom we have not been able to place in appropriate positions.

To gain more knowledge and understanding of the process and rights of members who require permanent accommodation, members can review Article N of the Local Collective Agreement.
