

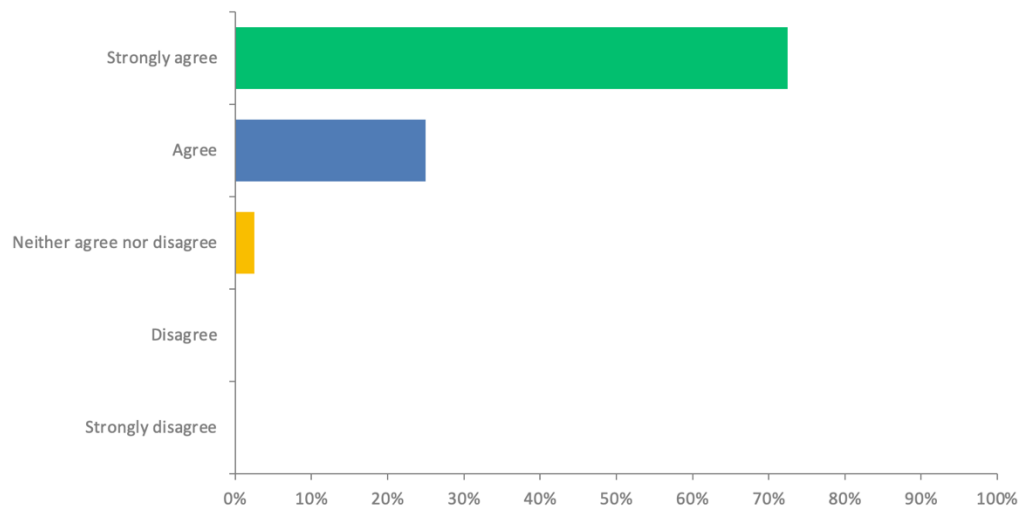
## ONA80 2025 National Nursing and Respiratory Therapists Week Events Survey Results

The survey was created on **October 21, 2025**, and received **40 responses**, being available until November 19, 2025, with 97.5% of responders were from Sunnybrook Hospital RN ONA members.

- **87.5%** of respondents were aware that Nursing Week is celebrated during the second week of May.
- **55%** knew that National Respiratory Therapists Week occurs annually during the last full week of October.
- **More than 77%** either agreed or strongly agreed that National Nursing and the RT Weeks are the unique opportunity to celebrate professional achievements.

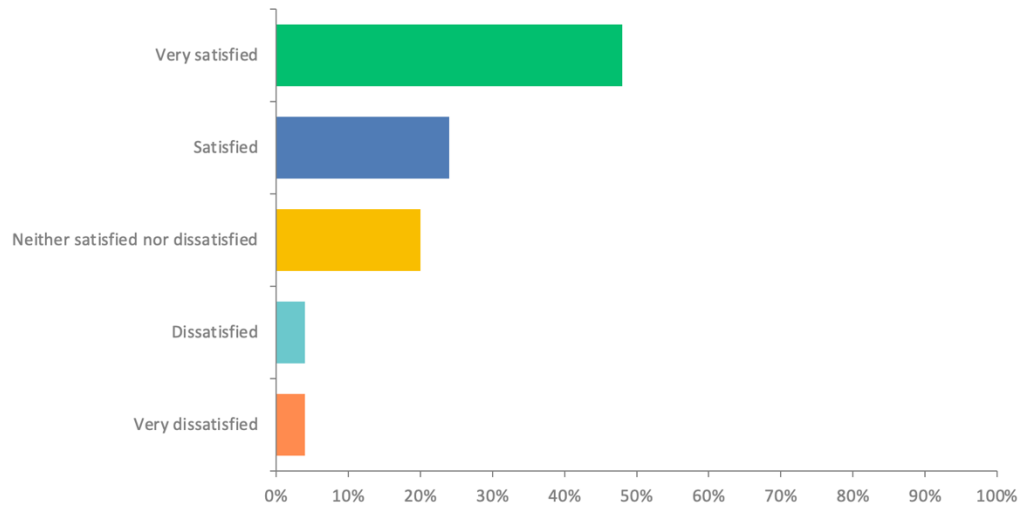


### 2025 Gala Feedback:

- **56%** of all respondents attended the 2025 Nursing Week Gala. Of those:
  - and of those, **72%** were either **very satisfied** or **satisfied** with the event.
- Two respondents indicated their dissatisfaction.

## Q6: How would you rate your overall satisfaction with the ONA80 Gala Dinner held on May 14, 2025?

Answered: 25 Skipped: 15



- **79%** were satisfied with the venue—Parkview Manor in Toronto
- **total 70%** expressed satisfaction with the **food and drinks** indicating either satisfied or very satisfied
- some **16%** were neither satisfied nor dissatisfied and **12.5%** expressed their dissatisfaction

Answered: 24 Skipped: 16

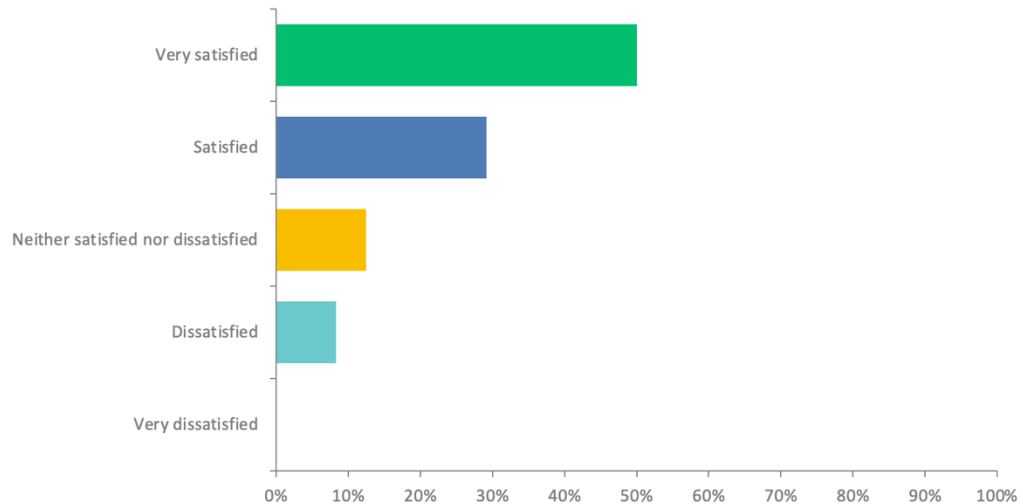

Answered: 24 Skipped: 16

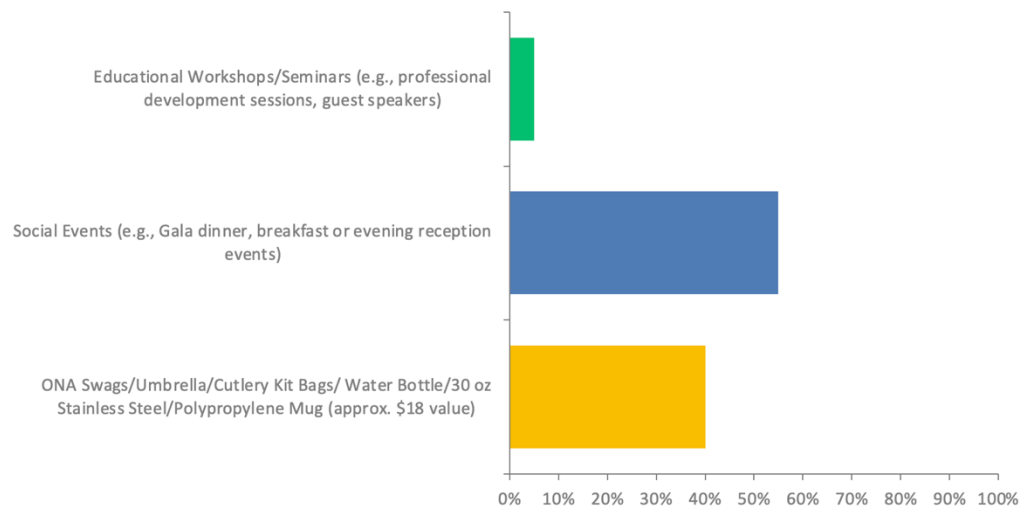


We heard you loud and clear:

## Additional general Feedback and Suggestions for planning ONA80 celebrations in 2026:

- **Take away points provided by members:**

As we begin planning for the 2026 Nursing and Respiratory Therapy Week, members shared great ideas and reflections that will help shape the events ahead.

There was clear appreciation for the Gala and the chance to gather in person, with many noting how meaningful it is to celebrate outside of work. At the same time, members asked for more inclusive planning—especially when it comes to night-shift staff who often miss out due to scheduling.

Several responses pointed out that while the Gala is a highlight, the experience would benefit from a refresh: new menu options, different entertainment, and updated activities to keep it exciting.

Others suggested better seating arrangements, such as grouping by unit or department, to make the evening more enjoyable.

The feedback also reminded us to keep things balanced—some want swag, others prefer in-hospital treats like food or raffles. But the final direction for how we will be celebrating in 2026 is shaped by what the majority of members clearly asked for: social gatherings, breakfast or evening receptions, and the Gala dinner. That is where the focus will be as we move forward with planning.

All in all, the message was clear: continue building on what works for majority, and keep evolving to make the celebrations fun, and meaningful for everyone.

We thank everyone who took the time to respond and share their feedback. As we gear up for a busy start to 2026, we are also moving ahead with planning for the upcoming Nursing and Respiratory Therapy Week celebrations.
